A vehicle of which you are shown as the registered keeper has been seen exceeding the speed limit in one of our Community Concern areas.

If you were not driving the vehicle at the time, can you please forward this letter to the person who was. If you are no longer the keeper of the vehicle can I remind you to notify DVLA as you are still legally responsible for the vehicle.

Bedfordshire and Luton Casualty Reduction Partnership and our volunteers would like drivers of vehicles to slow down to save lives. On this occasion it is felt that education rather than enforcement is a suitable outcome. However enforcement activity may take place at this location in the future. Information gathered in relation to speeding vehicles will be used to target speed enforcement campaigns, educational opportunities and other road safety initiatives.
